## **Enrollment Summary:**

RIC's total enrollment crossed above 6,000 students for the first time since 2021. The enrollment growth over last year was driven by undergraduate students, particularly a 340-student increase in first-time, full-time students. The number of graduate students also increased slightly, though continues to fall below recent historic norms. RIC continues to qualify as an Hispanic Serving Institution (HSI), with Hispanic/Latiné undergraduate enrollment increased to 29%. Students of color make up 48% of the undergraduate student population and 27% of graduate students.


